

Alligator Cracking



Insufficient or deteriorated base flexes under heavy loads, causing cracks.



Surface is sealed or covered, but underlying base problem persists.

Overlay or



Cracks soon reappear and get worse.

Potholes

Rutting & Shoving



Cracks encircle areas that eventually are flipped out.



Potholes Mill and Fill

Pothole is filled or covered, but base is still compromised.

Mill and Fill



Cracks continue to surface; potholes reappear and widen.





Unstable, insufficient, or deteriorated base buckles and warps under heavy loads.



Raised areas are milled down and an overlay is applied.

A time-consuming and expensive process




Generally, the old asphalt has to be ripped up and hauled off, the subsurface replaced with new fill, the roadbed recompacted, and the road repaved.



How Full-Depth Reclamation Works

"Full-depth reclamation is a reclamation technique in which the full, flexible pavement section and a predetermined portion of the underlying materials are crushed, pulverized, or blended, resulting in a stabilized base course."


Superior Straight Edge


While the Asphalt Zipper is primarily used for full-depth reclamation, users are also realizing significant cost savings by using it for partialdepth milling operations as well.


